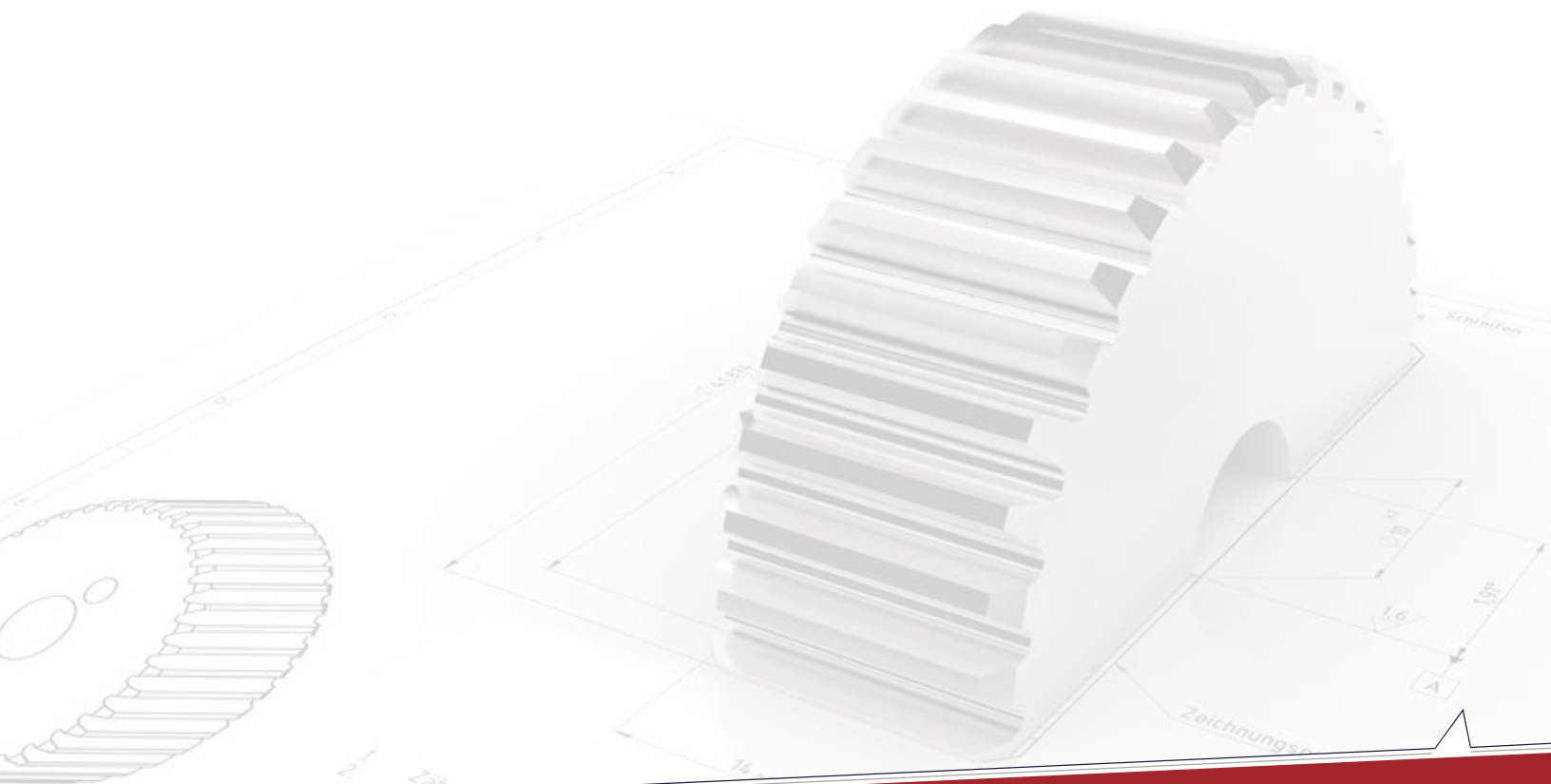

Accelerated Training Above average results

The average starting salary for our graduates is \$60,000 per year.

As we reflect on 2018, growth emerges as our defining theme.

Our graduates continue to make a positive impact by entering into advanced manufacturing careers with America's leading companies and institutions. On December 14, our Fall graduation ceremony brought our total alumni to 572 graduates who have earned 3,884 nationally recognized credentials.

We celebrated our 10th anniversary with a gala onboard the USS Midway that funded 17 student scholarships. Construction was completed on a state-of-the-art CAD/CAM 2 Classroom, making it possible to increase the number of students we serve by 25% annually. Throughout the year, valued partners have helped raise awareness and increase our reach online, in print and at trade shows.

In 2018, we stayed true to our mission and kept our minds focused on moving forward. Founder and CEO Hernán Luis y Prado brought fresh energy and leadership, and continues to spearhead initiatives that make lasting change in the lives of our servicemen and women.

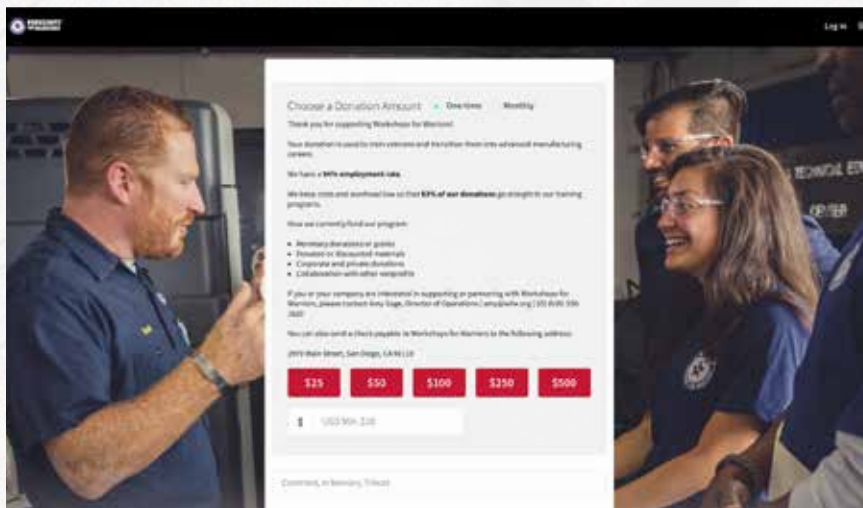

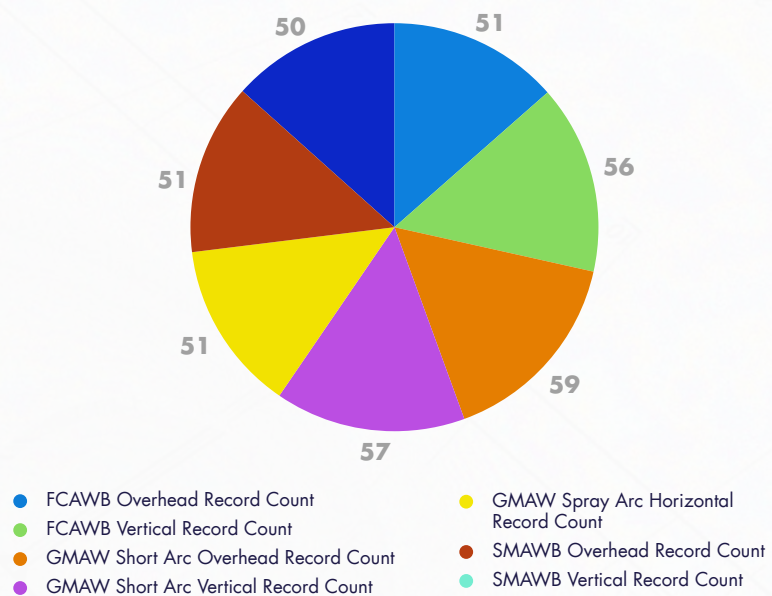

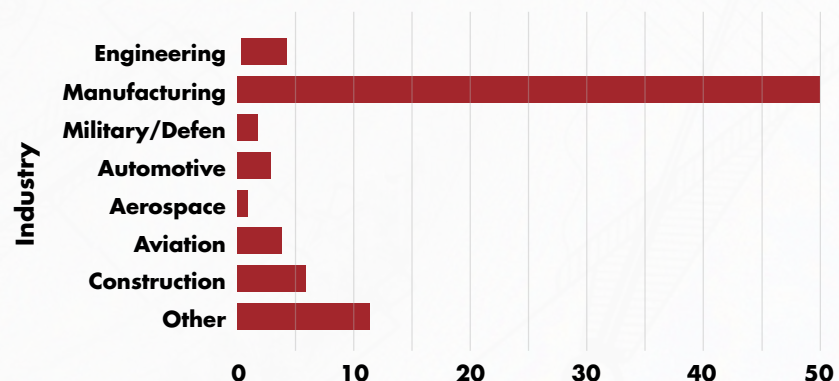

2018 Graduate Employment Status for Machining & Welding

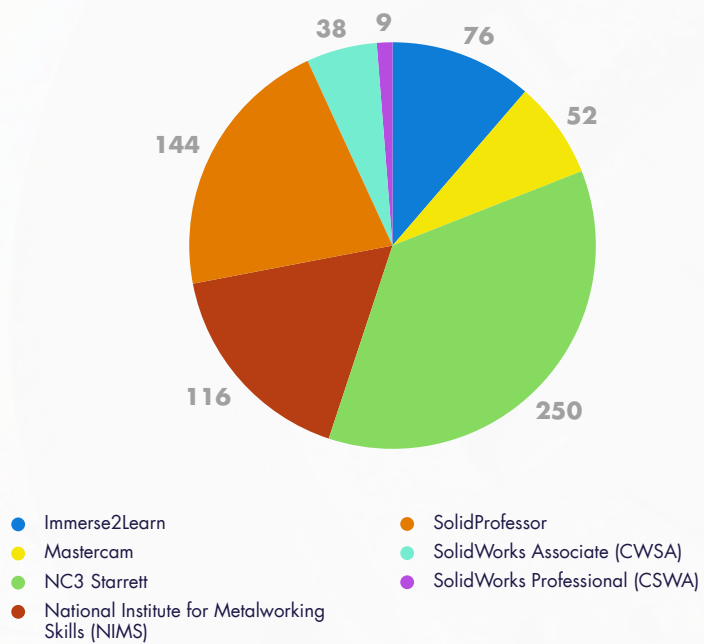

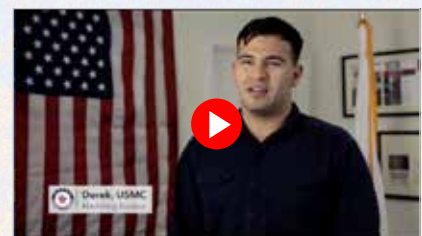
