# Student Story Alexi Ehrenberger



After discovering welding in high school, Alexi knew it was the path she wanted to follow. Seeking independence after graduation, she joined the Navy and served as a fireman in the engineering department. She thrived in the structure and adrenaline of military life, but found the transition to civilian life challenging after a medical discharge.

Determined to build a new future, Alexi enrolled at Workshops for Warriors. Balancing school and raising her young son largely on her own wasn't easy, but she found encouragement in her instructors and classmates. "They hype you up, make you feel good," she said. "It brings hope that you can be confident as a woman [welder], which helps a lot."

Through WFW's hands-on training and community support, Alexi rebuilt her confidence and rediscovered her purpose. During a WFW career fair, she received a job offer from Huntington Ingalls Industries, the nation's largest shipbuilder — her dream job.

Alexi states that the biggest impact WFW had on her was giving her purpose again. "I had nothing, but now I could have this career. I'm not just a mom that had nothing going on for myself. I could be someone in the trades. They gave me a sense of purpose."
